

Sidbury School Flood Management Project – CCTV Water Cam Install

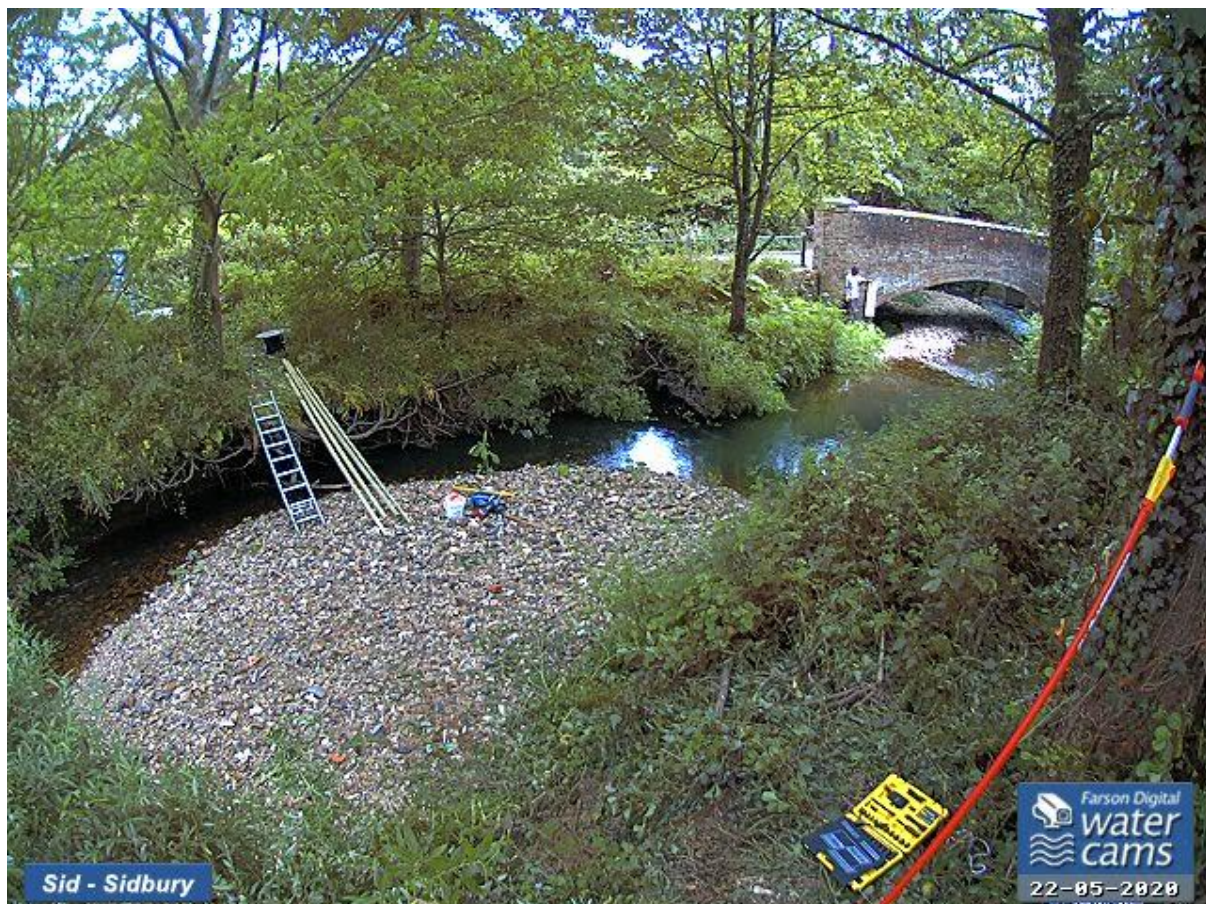
Summary

Further to the introduction in May 2020 of the Sidbury Flood Management Plan, Ventrus decided to invest in a state of the art, day and night vision camera, providing a 24hr x 365day, 10year coverage, this will assist both the school and the local community to monitor water levels in times of heavy rainfall to protect their properties and provide an early warning so action can be taken to safeguard buildings and lives.

Farson Digital who is a community-based webcam installer and service provider, worked closely with Ventrus in implementing this project to ensure the camera was strategically placed to ensure that only public areas are transmitted. They regularly work with and supply services to the Environment Agency, The Scottish Environment Protection Agency, Councils, Businesses, Flood Groups and River Trusts.
